Fabric Requirements

Blocks

1 Dottie Jelly Roll (45010JR) (You will be using 36 of the 40-2½" x width of fabric strips)

Background

1 Bella Solid Jelly Roll (9900JR 98) (40-2¹/₂" x width of fabric strips) ¹/₂ yard (9900 98)

Binding

³⁄₄ yard (45009 49)

Backing: 41/2 yards

Featured fabric is Dottie by Moda

Dottie moda Quilt is 72" x 72".

Fabric Cutting

Background (3 strips from Bella Solid Jelly Roll and 6 strips from $\frac{1}{2}$ yard) From 3-2¹/₂" x width of fabric strips, cut 24-2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangles. From 6-2¹/₂" x width of fabric strips, cut 48-2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂" rectangles.

Binding

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8-2¹/₂" x width of fabric strips Sew the strips end to end for the binding.

Construction (Use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press in the direction of the arrows.)

To make one block

(A) Join 1 print and 1 background 2½" x width of fabric strip. Cut the strip set into 8-2½" and 4-4½" wide segments. Join 2-2½" wide segments. Make 3. Join 1-2½" segment and 1-4½" x 2½" background rectangle. Make 2.



(B) Arrange and sew the units in rows as shown. Join the rows to make 1 block. Repeat to make 36 blocks.





2 Arrange and sew 6 rows in 6 blocks each as shown. Press the seams in opposite direction from row to row. Join the rows. Layer, quilt and bind.



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
