



Flower Petals:

- (A) Sew a gathering stitch on the curved side of the half circles. Start and stop at least a ¼" from the edges. Be sure to leave a long tail at both ends to use for gathering the stitches.
- (B) Fold the Petal in half, right sides together, and sew a $^{1\!}4^{\prime\prime}$ seam as shown.
- (C) Turn right side out. *Hint: Use a Revlon Emery File to extend the point then press.* Pull the threads to make the Petal. Make 8 petals from each print for a total of 30 sets of 8 Flower Petals.



Flower Centers: Make a 2¼" Center template. Draw 30 centers on the non-sticky side of the fusible web. Loosely cut out around the centers. Position the center on *right side* of a 2¾" fabric square, sticky side down, *do not press*, stitch in place. Trim a scant ¼" from the stitched line, slit the web, turn the center right side out. Finger press the edges, *do not iron!* Repeat to make 30 Centers.



Quilter Basics

Read instructions before beginning a project.

- All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance; WOF=width of fabric.
- 22" measurement is approximate; 22" may indicate cutting the length of
 - a fat quarter or cutting the width of fabric strip in half
 - To make one Flower: Select $1-6\frac{1}{2}x6\frac{1}{2}$ and $8-3\frac{1}{2}x3\frac{1}{2}$ squares from one Print.
 - (A) Draw a diagonal line on the back of the 3¹/₂" squares.
 - (B) Sew one 3¹/₂" square on the diagonal to 1-6¹/₂"x 3¹/₂" Background rectangle. Trim ¹/₄" from the sewn line. Press to the corner to form a triangle. Add another 3¹/₂" square to the same rectangle. Trim and press. Make four.
 - (C) Combine units as shown to make one Flower. Repeat to make a total of 30 Flowers, one from each print.



4 Assemble the Flower Block: Pin the Petals, one at a time, on the block as shown. Iron the Flower Center in the middle then stitch in place.



Flower Block Make 30 12½"x 12½" with seams

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5 Sew 5 Flower Blocks into a row. Make 6 rows. Combine the rows to make the quilt top. Add the 3¹/₂" Final Borders sides first then top and bottom.



6 Sew the 8–2½"x WOF Binding strips together. Layer, quilt and bind. ENJOY!





Fabric requirements

Flower Petals & Blocks: 30 Assorted Fat Quarters Centers: One Fat Quarter (18"x 22")

Background, Final Border & Binding: 41/2 yards (We used 9900 41 Bella Solid)

Fusible Web: 1/4 yard Backing: 41/2 yards

Cutting

Flower Petals & Blocks: from EACH of 30 fat quarters cut:** 1-61/2"x 22" strip subcut 1-61/2"x 61/2" 2-31/2"x 22" strips subcut 8-31/2"x 31/2" from the remainder cut 8-6" half circles



Centers:

5-23/4"x 22" strips subcut 30-23/4"x 23/4" squares

Background, Final Border & Binding:

38-31/2"x WOF strips combine the strips subcut 2-31/2"x 721/2" strips 2-31/2"x 661/2" strips subcut 120-31/2"x 61/2" 120-31/2"x 31/2" 8-21/2"x WOF strips
